Galatians 6:7-10

BIBLICAL EXPOSITION & ANNOTATION:

“The Righteous Shall Live By Faith”

**"It is for freedom that Christ has set you free. Therefore,
do not let yourself be yoked again by the slavery of the law"**

⁷ Do not be deceived (*Πλανάω [plan-ah'-o] led astray, wander in wrong direction*): **God cannot be mocked** (*μωκτηρίζω [mook-tay-rid'-zo] sneered at, found in contempt of the truth*).

A man reaps (*θερίζω [ther-id'-zo] gathers, harvest*) **what he sows** (*σπείρω [spi'-ro] spread seeds, scatters seeds*). **⁸ Whoever sows** (*spreads seeds*) **to please their flesh, from the flesh will reap** (*gather a harvest*) **destruction; whoever sows** (*spreads seeds*) **to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap** (*gather a harvest*) **eternal life.**

⁹ Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up. ¹⁰ Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all (*πᾶς [pas] every kind of*) **people, especially to those who belong to the family of faith.**
